Web of Knowledge (formerly known as <u>ISI</u> Web of Knowledge) is an academic <u>citation indexing</u> and search service, which is combined with web linking and is provided by <u>Thomson Reuters</u>. Web of Knowledge covers the sciences, <u>social sciences</u>, arts and <u>humanities</u>. It provides <u>bibliographic</u> content and tools to access, analyze, and manage research information. Multiple databases can be searched simultaneously.

Web of Science (WoS, previously known as Web of Knowledge) is an online subscription-based scientific citation indexing service maintained by Thomson Reuters that provides a comprehensive citation search. It gives access to multiple databases that reference cross-disciplinary research, which allows for in-depth exploration of specialized sub-fields within an academic or scientific discipline.

Web of Science consist of seven online databases: [12][9]

- <u>Conference Proceedings Citation Index</u> covers more than 160,000 conference titles in the Sciences starting from 1990 to the present day
- <u>Science Citation Index Expanded</u> covers more than 8,500 notable journals encompassing 150 disciplines. Coverage is from the year 1900 to the present day.
- <u>Social Sciences Citation Index</u> covers more than 3,000 journals in social science disciplines. Range of coverage is from the year 1900 to the present day.
- Arts & Humanities Citation Index covers more than 1,700 arts and humanities journals starting from 1975. In addition, 250 major scientific and social sciences journals are also covered.
- <u>Index Chemicus</u> lists more than 2.6 million compounds. The time of coverage is from 1993 to present day.
- <u>Current Chemical Reactions</u> indexes over one million reactions, and the range of coverage is from 1986 to present day. The *INPI* archives from 1840 to 1985 are also indexed in this database.
- <u>Book Citation Index</u> covers more than 60,000 editorially selected books starting from 2005.

Scopus is a <u>bibliographic database</u> containing <u>abstracts</u> and <u>citations</u> for <u>academic journal articles</u>. It covers nearly 21,000 titles from over 5,000 publishers, of which 20,000 are <u>peer-reviewed</u> journals in the scientific, technical, medical, and social sciences (including arts and humanities). It is owned by <u>Elsevier</u> and is available online by <u>subscription</u>. Searches in Scopus also incorporate searches of patent databases.

Ulrich's Periodicals Directory (<u>ISSN</u> <u>0000-0175</u>, and <u>ISSN</u> <u>0000-2100</u>) is the standard library directory and <u>database</u> providing information about popular and academic <u>magazines</u>, <u>scientific journals</u>, <u>newspapers</u> and other serial publications.^[1]

It is now also supplied on-line as **Ulrichsweb**, which includes over 300,000 active and current periodicals.

WorldCat is a <u>union catalog</u> that itemizes the collections of 72,000 <u>libraries</u> in 170 countries and territories^[1] which participate in the <u>Online Computer Library Center</u> (OCLC) global cooperative. It is built and maintained collectively by the participating libraries.

Inspec is a major indexing database of scientific and technical literature, published by the <u>Institution of Engineering and Technology</u> (IET), and formerly by the <u>Institution of Electrical Engineers</u> (IEE), one of the IET's forerunners.

IEEE *Xplore* is a scholarly research <u>database</u> that indexes, abstracts, and provides full-text for articles and papers on <u>computer science</u>, <u>electrical engineering</u> and <u>electronics</u>. The database mainly covers material from the <u>Institute of Electrical and Electronics</u> Engineers (IEEE) and the Institution of Engineering and Technology. [11]

The content in IEEE Xplore comprises over 180 journals, over 1,400 conference proceedings, more than 3,800 technical standards, over 1,800 eBooks and over 400 educational courses. Approximately 20,000 new documents are added to IEEE Xplore each month.

The **Association for Computing Machinery** (**ACM**) is a U.S.-based international <u>learned society</u> for <u>computing</u>. It was founded in 1947 and is the world's largest^[2] scientific and educational <u>computing</u> society. It is a not-for-profit professional membership group. ^[3] Its membership is more than 100,000 as of 2011. Its headquarters are in New York City.

PubMed is a free search engine accessing primarily the <u>MEDLINE</u> <u>database</u> of references and abstracts on life sciences and biomedical topics. The <u>United States</u> <u>National Library of Medicine</u> (NLM) at the <u>National Institutes of Health</u> maintains the database as part of the <u>Entrez</u> system of <u>information retrieval</u>.

Compendex, is the computerized version of the Engineering Index,. It is an engineering bibliographic database. It indexes scientific literature pertaining to engineering materials. Beginning in 1884, it was compiled by hand under the original title of Engineering Index. As a result of computerization in 1967, the first electronic Engineering Index bulletin was sent to 500 subscribers.

CINAHL (Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature) is an index of English-language and selected other-language journal articles about <u>nursing</u>, allied health, biomedicine and healthcare.^[1]

The publisher, Cinahl Information Systems, was acquired by <u>EBSCO Publishing</u> in 2003. [2]

CiteSeer was a public <u>search engine</u> and <u>digital library</u> for scientific and academic papers, primarily in the fields of <u>computer</u> and <u>information science</u> that has been replaced by **CiteSeer**^x. Many consider it to be the first academic paper search engine.

The **Directory of Open Access Journals** (**DOAJ**) is <u>website</u> that lists <u>open access</u> <u>journals</u> and is maintained by Infrastructure Services for Open Access (IS4OA). Until January 2013, the DOAJ was maintained by <u>Lund University</u>. The project defines open access journals as <u>scientific</u> and <u>scholarly journals</u> that meet high quality standards by exercising <u>peer review</u> or editorial quality control and "use a funding model that does not charge readers or their institutions for access." The <u>Budapest Open Access Initiative</u>'s definition of <u>open access</u> is used to define required rights given to users, for the journal to be included in the DOAJ, as the rights to "read, download, copy, distribute, print, search, or link to the full texts of these articles".

The **Open Access Scholarly Publishers Association (OASPA)** is an industry association which aims to promote <u>open access publishing</u> (also known as Gold Open Access) and to establish best practices in the field. It brings together the major open access publishers on the one hand and independent — often <u>society</u>- or university-based — publishers on the other, along with some <u>hybrid open access publishers</u>. While having started out with a focus on <u>open access journals</u> exclusively, it is now expanding its activities to include matters pertaining to the open access publishing of books as well. DBLP is a computer science bibliography website hosted at Universität Trier, in Germany. It was originally a database and logic programming bibliography site, and has existed at least since the 1980s. DBLP listed more than 2.3 million articles on computer science in October 2013. All important journals on computer science are tracked. Proceedings papers of many conferences are also tracked. It is mirrored at five sites across the Internet. [1][2][3][4]

Thomson ISI Impact Factor:

The impact factor of a *Journal A* in a particular year *Y* is calculated as follows:

All citations in Y to articles in A during (Y-1) + (Y-2)

All citable articles in A during (Y-1) + (Y-2)
